II. Evaluation Considerations:

As described in the Bylaws of the Board of Regents, each faculty member must be evaluated annually. This requirement holds regardless of whether the faculty member is on leave for all or part of the evaluation period. Moreover, that evaluation must follow the faculty member's apportionment/position description. It is therefore important that the chair/head/director and the faculty member agree ahead of time on what work, if any, is expected during the leave, and how that work will be evaluated. In some cases, a temporary reappportionment of duties may be appropriate, for the duration of the leave. In cases of leaves without pay, no work should be expected of the faculty member during the period of the leave, and the apportionment should be set to "0" in every category. If a temporary reappportionment is appropriate, or if the leave is taken without pay or with partial pay, then the method for completing the overall evaluation when the period of evaluation overlaps with the dates of the leave should also be clarified. In cases of unplanned/emergency leaves, please write "TBD by (date)" in the space at the end of this section, leave the remainder of this section blank, and plan to submit a second copy of this form by the date indicated.
